I, (***please print clearly***) _____ hereby apply to participate in the Graduation ceremonies of the Class of 2014. I agree to abide by the following stipulations:

- 1) Attendance at the Academic Convocation on Friday, May 23.
- 2) Participation in graduation rehearsals on Wednesday, May 28 and Thursday, May 29.
- 3) Participation in the Baccalaureate Liturgy on Thursday, May 29.
- 4) Attire for Baccalaureate Services and Graduation Exercises on Thursday, May 29 and Saturday, May 31.
 - Girls - Dress skirt or dressy trousers with blouse; **no flip-flops**, dress shoes only.
 - Boys - **white shirt & tie**; **no flip-flops**, dress shoes only.
- 5) Grooming for Baccalaureate Services and Graduation Exercises:
 - Boys – Hair and sideburns properly trimmed in accordance with stated school policy, and no facial hair.
 - Girls and Boys - No dyed or bleached hair, and no facial piercings or jewelry.
- 6) Cap and gown will be worn in the conventional manner with no modification or embellishments. Graduating seniors are encouraged to wear their retreat crosses.
- 7) All library books, I pads and athletic equipment must be returned.
- 8) Any misconduct during practice, Baccalaureate Mass or the Graduation Ceremony may result in the student not receiving his/her diploma.
- 9) Senior pranks are considered misconduct. Offenders will be liable for disciplinary action which may include non-participation in the Commencement Exercises.
- 10) Observance of the Senior Prom regulations as stated in the letter to parents.
- 11) Lastly, please no flowers or leis until after the graduation ceremony.
