



WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THE SI TUITION?

The Full Tuition Amount equals the actual cost to educate the student each year.

YOUR TUITION AMOUNT INCLUDES:

Registration Deposit

The registration deposit is not an additional fee at SI. If you are accepted at SI, you will pay a \$1,600 non-refundable deposit to reserve your place in the class. \$1,500 of the non-refundable deposit will be applied to your tuition account reducing your tuition by that amount.

Retreats

Our four-year Retreat Program through Campus Ministry is all inclusive. All overnight accommodations, meals, snacks, and transportation are covered.

Learning Center - CATS

All students have access to our Center for Academics & Targeted Support [CATS]. CATS serves all students, including personal student academic support, students with documented learning differences and/or ADHD, and students needing academic accommodations.

Technology Fee

SI does not charge a separate fee for technology support and access.

Yearbook

All students receive a yearbook each year during their four years at SI at no additional charge.

Advising

In addition to their personal counselor, all students will have a college counselor for guidance in this specific area. Students also have access to our College Athletics Advisor to navigate the college process.

Class Activities

Most class activities that include the entire class are covered, including Friday Nights Lights games, Tailgates, and Spirit Activities. There is an additional charge for dances/proms.

Clubs

Our 125+ clubs do not charge a fee to join.

There may be a small additional cost for some club activities, such as field trips, competition entry fees, etc.; however, many of the club activity costs are covered or supplemented.

Weight Room Workouts

Throughout the school day, specifically during a student's resource period, all students have access to our weight room and other athletic facilities for workouts, including a qualified training coach to guide them.

Graduation

Cap and Gown, Awards Day celebrations, Diploma, Baccalaureate Mass Tickets and Graduation Tickets are included.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Background

Money provided from our endowment is used to help create the most diverse and talented student population. The goal is to give an opportunity to those who may not otherwise have the means to gain the benefit of a Jesuit education. At SI, financial assistance provided is need based. That means that the dollars provided for our families is based on the ability to pay based on a financial analysis.

Jesuit Philosophy

We believe an important part of a Jesuit education is learning and growing by studying alongside peers who bring a variety of gifts and talents from diverse backgrounds. In order to fulfill this educational goal, we need to provide financial assistance to students who do not have the means to attend SI. We hope families will understand the importance of this educational goal and why our financial assistance is need based.

Scholarships

You may hear of a student at SI who was awarded a scholarship. We honor the donors who have provided the funds for financial assistance by naming it after a person, family or class. For example, one of our many scholarships is the Class of 1955 scholarship. The graduates of this class have contributed funds and we draw from these funds to provide financial assistance. This is our way of thanking donors. Scholarships are not provided based on academic standing or other merit-based criteria.
